

Comparing Apples with Apples: Questions to Ask When Choosing a Flexible Workspace Provider

When you're researching flexible workspace providers, make sure you're comparing apples with apples. Not all memberships are created equal - work through this handy checklist to help you find the best fit for your business.

1. Where is it based?

Everyone knows it's all about 'location, location, location.' Look for coworking spaces in locations your staff will love, close to quality amenities and with easy transport access. Premium locations might cost more, but will help you attract and retain talent.

Also, consider whether there are multiple locations that you can take advantage of. Are you based in Auckland but meeting clients in Wellington? Check to see if you can use meeting spaces in other branches of the workspace provider.



2. What kind of amenities & utilities are there?

Ensure that the space includes everything you need to keep your business running smoothly, with consideration to what's most important for your business.

Some things to look out for include:

Cleaning and maintenance services - what's included? Printing, scanning, and photocopying facilities what's included in your membership? Inclusion of utilities, such as power, in the monthly Kitchen or break room with coffee and snacks membership fee Access to office supplies and equipment High-speed internet access High quality office furniture, including desks, Break out spaces for informal staff meetings chairs, and storage **Event spaces** Enough meeting rooms so that you can easily App or member portal for space booking book one when you need it and events Private spaces for confidential discussions, Onsite support, including reception and IT help and call pods for speaking on the phone Onsite cafes and bars Quiet spaces Outdoor spaces and plants Client-facing lounge spaces for informal catch ups or hosting opportunities Thoughtful interior design

3. How flexible are the plans?

One of the best things about flexible workspaces is that they are...flexible. It's all in the name! Do the membership options on offer cater to your team's needs? Is the provider willing to adapt your membership as your business needs change, or if anything unexpected happens?

Ask about your options when it comes to:

Flexible membership plans

Ability to scale up or down as your needs change

24/7 access or extended operating hours

Ability to customise packages for your company-specific needs

TIP: Smaller or local providers tend to be more agile and flexible with their offering compared to global operators, who may have a more fixed product approach.



4. What community & networking opportunities are available?

Working in a coworking space alongside other businesses offers the perfect opportunity to network and collaborate. Some providers will organise events and workshops to help facilitate these connections.

6. What kind of tech infrastructure is in place?



7. What's the work environment like?


When you feel good at work, you do good work. A positive work environment can boost productivity, reduce stress, and help you retain employees.

There are a few hidden costs to look out for:

- If you require access to meeting rooms regularly, make sure you build this into your plan upfront. The bill can creep up if you don't have meeting room bookings allocated within your monthly price.
 - The included cleaning service might not cover your needs if you're a cleanliness fanatic, so you might need to factor in extra costs here.
 - Will you be needing to use a printer regularly? Check to see what printing allowances are included in your membership.
